

## **Urban Village Scholarship Program**

This scholarship will be available to residents of Urban Village Apartments who are seeking education or skills-training opportunities at or beyond a high school level or to obtain a GED. This program was developed by Ownership, the Resident Services Staff, and the Urban Village Community Center Association, as a way to defray costs of higher education or training for residents at Urban Village.

***Scholarship money may be used towards any of the following costs associated with an education program:***

- Tuition or program fees
- Books, and supplies for classes
- Other program related costs

**Types of programs that would be considered include but are not limited to:** GED classes and employment skills and education such as: home health aide/medical aide trainings, construction and other apprenticeship programs, and classes at a local school, college, or university.

**Interested candidates will be required to submit an application form and submit a *Personal Statement and a Statement of Need.***

**The Personal Statement should include the following:**

- A short paragraph describing the candidate's previous education (high school/GED, extracurricular activities, skills training).
- A paragraph describing the candidate's goal in seeking further education/training.

**The Statement of Need should include the following:**

- The name of the program that the candidate is currently enrolled in or has applied for
- Information on the duration of the program, projected graduation/completion date, and current status in the program.
- A contact person/staff from that program.
- A description of the financial support required.

**If selected for a scholarship, all candidates will be required to show proof of enrollment and program completion. This may include (depending on the program):**

- Proof of Enrollment from Registrar
- Progress Reports
- Certificate of Completion
- Receipt and/or invoices for scholarship expenses

\*\* A panel of representatives from Urban Village ownership, management, and the Board will review all applications. These scholarships will not necessarily cover the full costs associated with any one program. Most recipients will find that these scholarships can be used to assist with covering a portion of the program cost. \*\*
